Our capstone design project focuses on the understanding of key concepts in **design, manufacturing and the application of solar cells and 3D modeling which covers both the theoretical and experimental aspects.**

This program will enhance participant’s Communication, Cooperation, Creativity and Problem Solving skills by teaming up with people of diverse nationalities and cultural backgrounds.

- Students recommended by the International Office from KOREATECH’s partner universities are eligible to apply for the program
- Applicant’s study field have to be in engineering field and Applicants need to be proficient English as all the programs will be provided in English.

Medical Insurance
